## **NOTTINGHAM PISCATORIAL SOCIETY - VISITING MATCH REQUIREMENTS**

THESE ARE MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL VISITING CLUBS AND THEIR ANGLERS.

If a visiting club is observed to not follow the Society's requirements. Any officer of the Society or an appointed bailiff may ask for the match to be stopped and no pegging refund will be given.

VISITING CLUB  VENUE  MATCH DATE			
		•	All matches are a maximum of 5 hours duration and must be finished by 4pm.
•	Vehicles must be parked ONLY in Society car parks. Tracks must not be blocked by anglers vehicles at any time.		
•	Many of our stretches are known for their barbel catches. Please ensure all anglers use appropriate tackle and that rods are not left unattended when in use.		
•	All Anglers must have two keepnets which must be placed into the water at the start of the match.		
•	A suitably sized landing net should be in use.		
•	All Barbel of 5lb and over must be weighed and returned to the water and NOT retained in a keepnet other than to secure a set of scales and witness. The angler must ensure appropriate care is taken with the fish and not cause any unnecessary stress to any fish caught.		
•	Barbel of under 5lb should be retained in the second net. When four barbel of any size under 5lb have been caught, they must be weighed and returned to the water.		
•	The Society may vary the fish size and number depending upon river/weather conditions. The Society Match Secretary will advise the visiting club secretary of any specific requirements.		
•	Any dead barbel should not be weighed in, and any fish killed must be reported to the Society Match Secretary.		
•	A set of scales must be available for every five anglers participating in the match in order to facilitate weighing in. If a visiting club does not have sufficient sets of scales, they must provide one or more Nor fishing stewards for weighing in.
